**The peer evaluation process for the
academic years**

At UBB level, the evaluation process for teaching staff activities was originally governed by a specific operational procedure, which was adopted by an Administrative Council Decision no. 30.058 on October 27, 2014. The document underwent revisions in 2018, 2022, and 2023; the current version approved by HCA 7575 on June 12, 2023, now titled *“Procedure for Evaluating the Activity of Teachers and Researchers by their Colleagues”*. It outlines the evaluation of teaching (dimension D1), research (dimension D2), and civic activities (dimension D3) – both to the benefit of UBB and of the broader community - along with measures for the valorization of results.

According to this document, each teacher/researcher undergoes formative evaluation at least once every three years, with the reference period being the last three academic years. The weighting for each dimension is tailored to the specific post and teaching position (as shown in the table below). The final score is the weighted average of the scores obtained for each dimension.

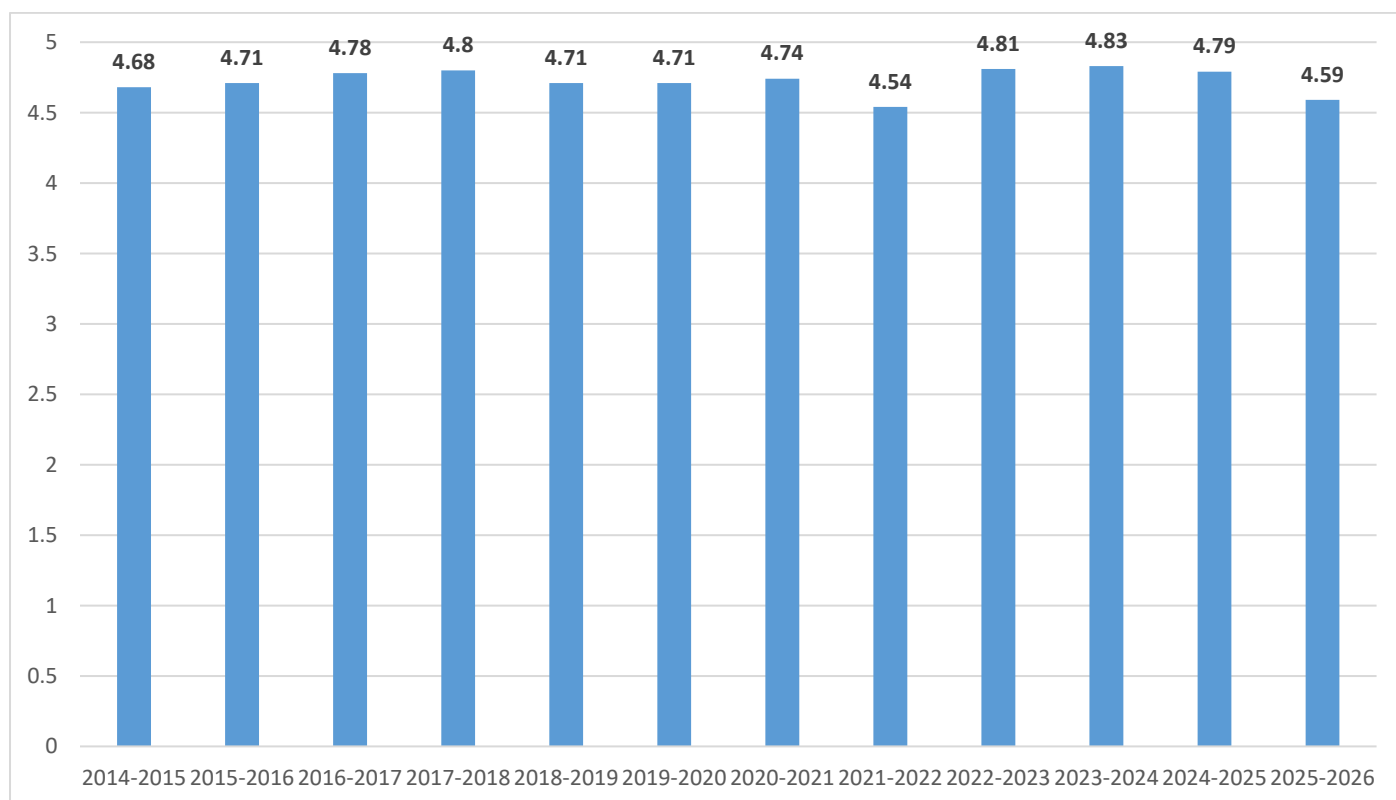


Figure 1. Weighted average scores across UBB, 2014/2015 – 2025/2026

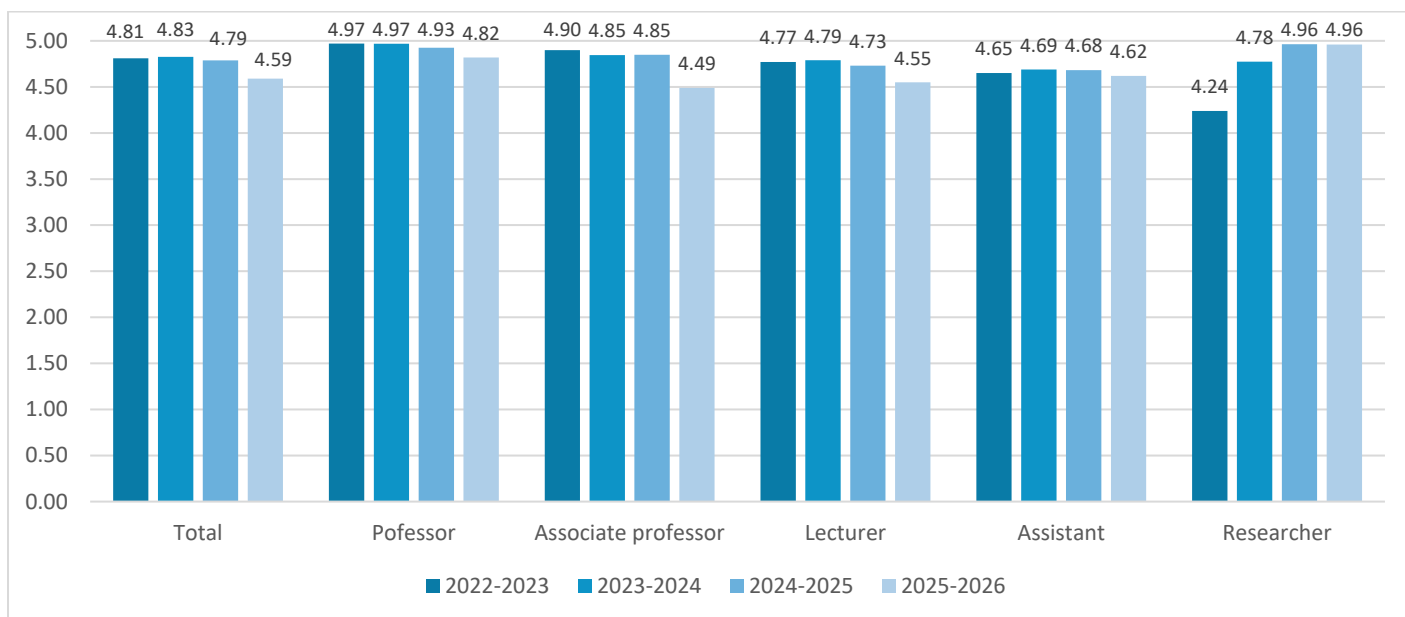


Figure 2. Weighted average scores obtained at UBB according to academic position/research rank, 2025-2026, compared to previous years

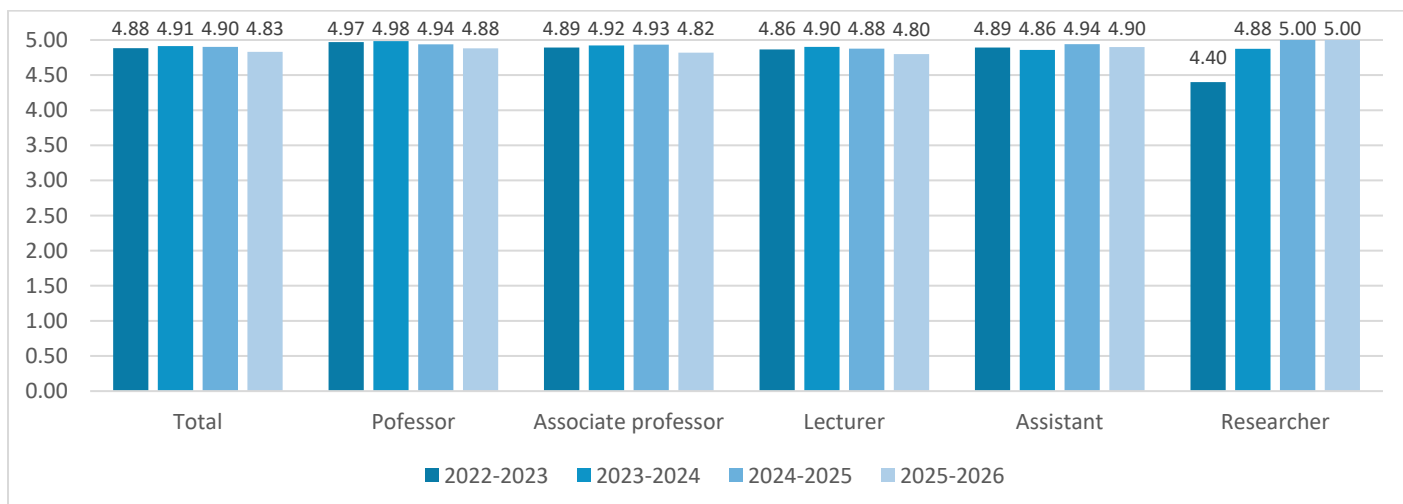


Figure 3. Weighted average scores obtained for Dimension D1 - Teaching activity, according to academic position / research rank, 2025-2026 compared to previous years

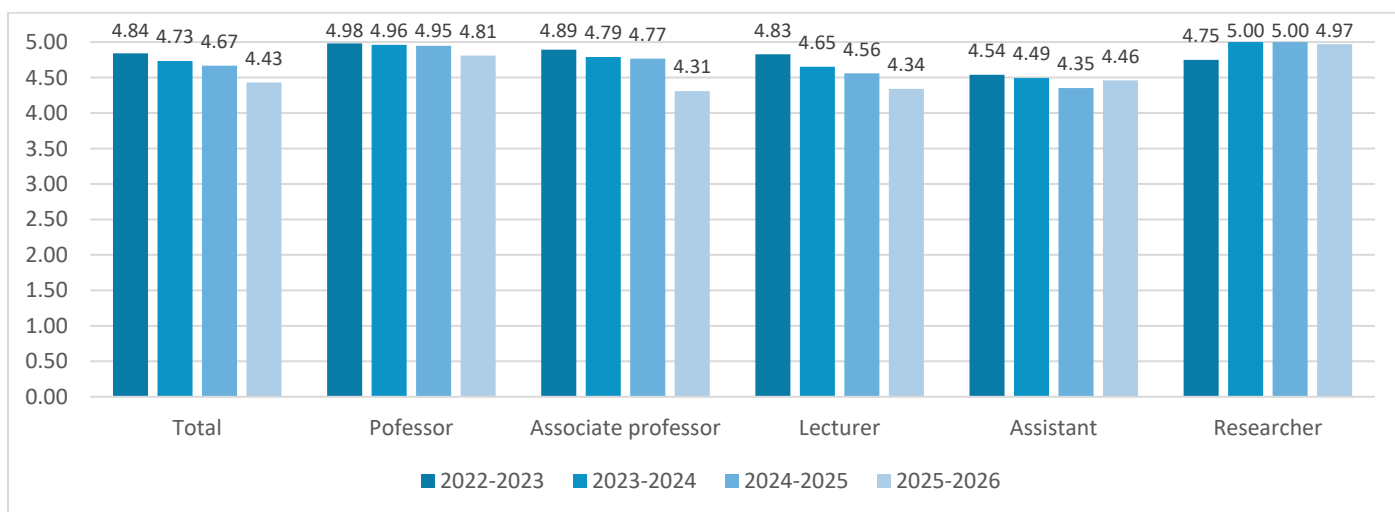


Figure 4. Weighted average scores obtained for Dimension D2 - Scientific research / artistic creation / sports performance, according to academic position/research rank, 2025-2026 compared to previous years

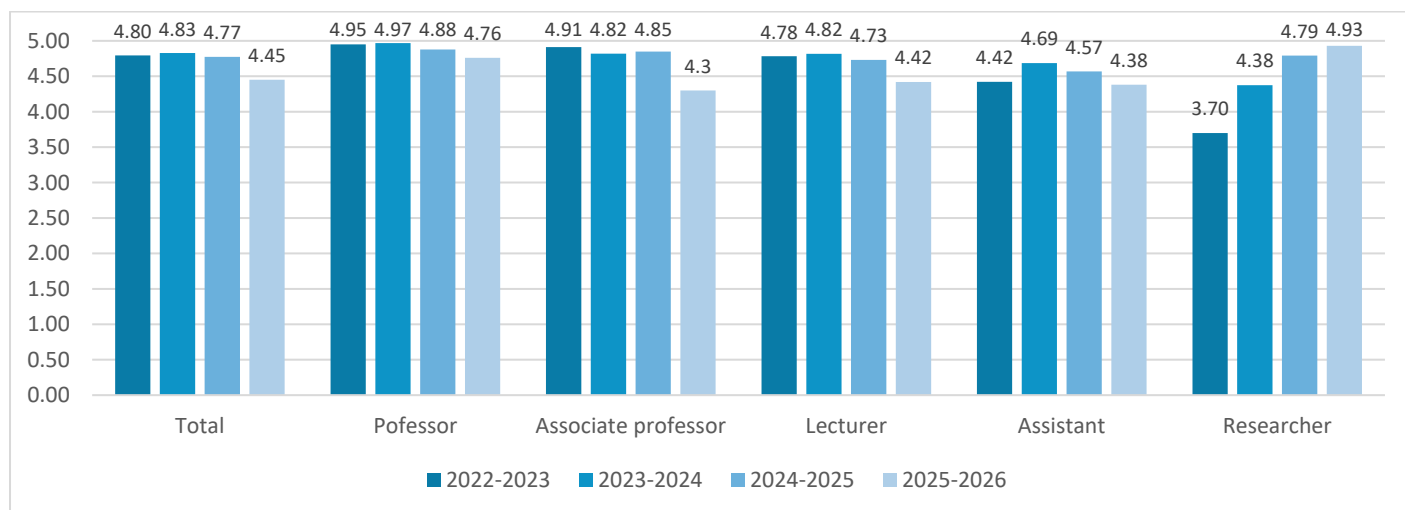


Figure 5. Weighted average scores obtained for Dimension D3 - Civic duties (pro-UBB and pro-society), according to academic position/research rank, 2025-2026 compared to previous years
