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According to the newly published 2022 edition of the global <u>QS World University Ranking by Subject Domains</u>, UBB is amongst the top 500 higher education institutions worldwide in 3 broad subject areas, including *Arts and Humanities* (ranked in the position 451-500 globally, and first nationally together with the University of Bucharest), *Natural Sciences* (451-500 global rank and first national rank together with the University of Bucharest) and *Social Sciences and Management* (401-450 global rank and first and only university at the national level).

Furthermore, according to the same ranking, UBB is one of the top universities worldwide in 10 subject areas (out of the 51 analysed and included in the ranking). Out of these, UBB is ranked first in Romania in 6 subjects, while in the remaining 4 it is ranked second in the country. The complete list of subjects and UBB's rank is shown in the table below.

News

By <u>decision</u> no. <u>3539/04.04.2022</u>, UBB's Administration Council approved the educational plans for the 2022/2023 academic year. The decision was approved by UBB's Senate.

By <u>decision</u> no. 3543/04.04.2022, UBB's Administration Council approved the modified and completed version of the methodology for occupying vacant teaching and research positions through competition.

UBB will benefit from campus investment backed by a new €35 million loan from the European Investment Bank. The investment will help transform and improve the research facilities and offices, while also improving energy efficiency.

Activities

The survey dedicated to measuring <u>students'</u> <u>satisfaction</u> towards the services offered by UBB has been finalized. Students from all academic levels were invited via email to take part in the survey. The deadline for completing the questionnaire was 14 April.

The process of <u>evaluating the professional activity of academic staff</u> by leadership has been completed at the level of faculties and academic units. The institutional report with the results of the evaluation is being prepared.

The Quality Assurance Manual has been thoroughly revised and updated. The new version will be uploaded to the website of the Qualitas Centre soon.

A new data collection phase has been completed for the upcoming editions of the *Times Higher Education* and *Clarivate* international rankings. The results will be published later this year.

The evaluation period for assessing the quality of the educational process by students is about to start. **Qualitas Centre** invites all students to complete the anonymous questionnaires using the **AcademicInfo platform**, or the mobile **UBBApp**, available on iOS and Android platforms. The evaluation periods are as follows:

Full-time education: 9 May – 29 May, 2022 Distance-learning and part-time education: 23 May – 5 June, 2022
