In the <u>2022 edition of the UI GreenMetric</u> ranking, Babeş–Bolyai University obtained 7445 points in total, placing it on the 228th position globally and 1st position on a national scale. Romania was represented by 11 universities in the current edition of the ranking.

In the $\underline{2022}$ edition of Round University Ranking, UBB is ranked second in the country, out of a total number of 14 Romanian universities included in the ranking. Globally, Babeş-Bolyai University occupies the 646^{th} position.
