According to the latest edition of the Scimago Institutions Rankings, Babeş-Bolyai University is the first university in the country out of the 30 Romanian universities included, while intertnationally it is ranked 1157th. In the Research Rank, Babeş-Bolyai University is placed in the 703rd position internationally and 1st position nationally. In the Societal Rank, UBB is the 1st university in the country, while at the international level it ranks 1057th. Finally, in the Innovation Rank, UBB ranks 2976th internationally and 15th nationally.
