Competitiveness No. 26 June 2023



According to the 2023 edition of the <u>Times Higher Education Impact Rankings</u> (which includes 1591 universities from 112 countries or regions), UBB is ranked 401-600th. At the national level, UBB is ranked 2nd together with the Bucharest University of Economic Studies. The University of Bucharest was ranked 1st in our country.

For the current edition, UBB collected and reported data for 8 individual Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The best score was achieved in SDG4 – Quality Education, where UBB is ranked 101-200th globally and 3rd at a national level.
