Competitiveness

In the 2021 edition of the <u>Times Higher</u> <u>Education Impact</u> ranking (which includes 1115 universities in 94 countries / regions) globally, UBB ranked 401-600, with an overall score of 62.3 points out of a maximum of 100 possible.

From the point of view of the individual Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), UBB ranked 101-200 in the Quality of Education (SDG 4), Gender Equality (SDG 5) and Climate Change Actions (SDG 13).

At national level, UBB occupies the second position (after the University of Bucharest), together with the Academy of Economic Studies and the Polytechnic University of Bucharest.

Activities


Between 14th and 20th April, the ARACIS Commission visited UBB, in order to evaluate and re-accredit the institution.
