The UBB Senate approved the curricula valid starting with the academic year 2021 - 2022 through <u>Decision no. 56 / 17.05.2021</u>.

The Board of Directors of UBB approved the *Gradual Petition Procedure at the UBB level* through <u>Decision no. 3975 / 26.04.2021</u>.



### Competitiveness

UBB is the most representative Romanian university based on the Essential Science Indicators (ESI) from the Web of Science (WoS) system, evaluated in the last decade (1.01.2011 - 28.02.2021), updated on May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

Globally, <u>UBB is the first university in the country</u>, being among the top 1% of the world's institutions that have essential contributions to science (1454 in the general analysis of institutions that, by the citations received, are among the top 1%). UBB is included in 9 of the 12 fields in which any institution in Romania is included: Psychology, Engineering, Environment / Ecology, Geosciences, Mathematics, Social Sciences, Plant and Animal Science, Chemistry and Physics.
