## **Competitiveness**

UBB has once again confirmed that it is one of the best performing universities in the country, with the launch of the ranking. QS World University Rankings by Subject. UBB is on the 401-450<sup>th</sup> position globally in the field of Arts and Humanities and the first in the country (along with UB), it is on the 401-450th position globally and the first in the country in the field of Social Sciences. The Business & Management field is the first in the country and 401-450<sup>th</sup> internationally, and Economics & Econometrics is second in the country and 451-500<sup>th</sup> globally. UBB is on the first position in the country (301-350th internationally) in Mathematics and the second in the country (301-350<sup>th</sup> globally) in Agriculture & Forestry (as a result of the scientific activities in the domains of biology/ecology). UBB is the first and only one in the country included in the field of Psychology (251-300th globally) and it occupies the second position in the country in the field of Medicine (601-650th globally). The IT field is on the second position in the country (the first in Cluj-Napoca) and on the 501-550<sup>th</sup> position globally.

The report on the evaluation, by the students, of the teaching activity is being elaborated.


The UBB presentation is being updated for the periodic evaluation/accreditation of the bachelor's and master's degree programs, as well as of the doctoral schools.


