According to the 2022 edition of the prestigious <u>Times Higher Education World University</u> <u>Ranking</u>, the academic school of arts and humanities at Babeş–Bolyai University is ranked first once again in the country, while internationally it is ranked in the 401-500th position.

Babeş-Bolyai University is once again ranked first in the country, according to the <u>2021 edition of the University Metaranking</u>, published on November 24. In total, 31 Romanian universities were included in this year's edition, and the ranking was published with support from the Ad Astra organisation.

By <u>Decision no. 14112/01.22.2021</u> of the Administration Council at the level of UBB, the office for ensuring the quality and integrity of doctorates was established.

By <u>Decision no. 14655/08.11.2021</u> of the Administration Council, new members of the Ethics Commission at the level of Babeş–Bolyai University have been approved.

Activities

In early November, the Romanian Higher Education Quality Assurance Agency (ARACIS) visited the doctoral schools of UBB for evaluation and re-accreditation. Members of the Qualitas Centre participated in the meetings.

During this period, the data collection and reporting for the 2022 edition of the international *Times Impact* ranking took place. The results are expected to be published in April next year.
