Following Decision no. 13353/21.09.2020 of UBB's Senate, the Regulation for the organization and functioning of the commission for quality assurance and evaluation (CEAC-UBB) was adopted.

The competition for the two places assigned to student representatives of NGOs from UBB took place in the first half of October.



Following Decision no. 13338/21.09.2020 the Regulation of the Scientific Council of Qualitas Center was approved.



Competitiveness

On October 10th the 2020 edition of the NTU ranking was launched (<u>Performace Ranking of Scientific Papers for World Univesities</u>). The ranking includes 826 universities world-wide. The global ranking does not include any Romanian university. However, UBB is ranked on <u>the 181st place in the field of Mathematics</u> (in the subjects ranking).

In the 2021 edition of the Best Global Universities ranking, UBB ranks 2nd on national level, 259th on European level and 595th on global level.

Activities

In early October, CQ completed the report regarding the assessment of UBB academics and researchers' professional activities by the management.

CQ is currently revising (i) the questionnaires regarding student satisfaction and (ii) the content of the document *Principles, criteria* and indicators of quality assurance in UBB.

In October, *Qualitas* Centre aims to monitors the nominal scheduling, on a semester basis, of the inter-evaluations for the academic year 2020-2021 and to draft the report for the inter-evaluations carried out during the 2019-2020 academic year.

In the second half of October, <u>new members</u> of <u>CEAC-UBB</u> were appointed, following UBB's Senate Decision no.

15486/19.10.2020. Moreover, CQ started the implementation of a coherent system, at institutional level for identifying the reasons for the non-completion / interruption / extension of a regular period of study.

- recruitment of students by higher education institutions;
- integration of students, prevention of school dropout, school dropout in higher education and academic success;
- · organizational psychology and human resource management in higher education.
