Following Decision no. 9470/13.07.2020 of UBB's Senate, the Centre for University Strategy and Quality Management has been structurally subdivided into the Qualitas Centre and the Centre for University Strategy.

In September, *Qualitas* Centre aims to (i) draft the report concerning the evaluation of the professional activity of the UBB academic body and researchers by the UBB management board, as well as to revise (ii) the surveys focusing on student satisfaction and (iii) the content of the document entitled *Principles, criteria and indicators of quality assurance in UBB*.



Competitiveness

The 2021 edition of the <u>QS World University</u> Ranking acknowledges UBB as national leader (alongside the University of Bucharest), in the 801-1000 international band.

The 2021 edition of the <u>Times Higher</u> <u>Education World University Ranking</u>, launched in September 2020, rates UBB as third on the national level, in the 1001+ international band. In terms of research output, UBB ranked first on the national level.

According to the 2020 edition of <u>CWTS Leiden</u> Ranking, UBB ranks first on the national level and occupies the 976th position internationally.


In the recently launched <u>CWUR</u> ranking, which includes 2000 international universities and 11 Romanian universities, UBB ranks first on the national level and features on the 862nd position overall.

UBB is granted the first position on the national level and the 830th place in the international hierarchy, according to the July 2020 edition of Webometrics.
